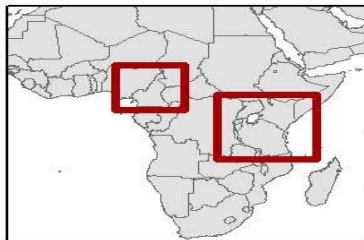


# HIV Prevalence Among Women and Men in Cameroon, Kenya and Tanzania

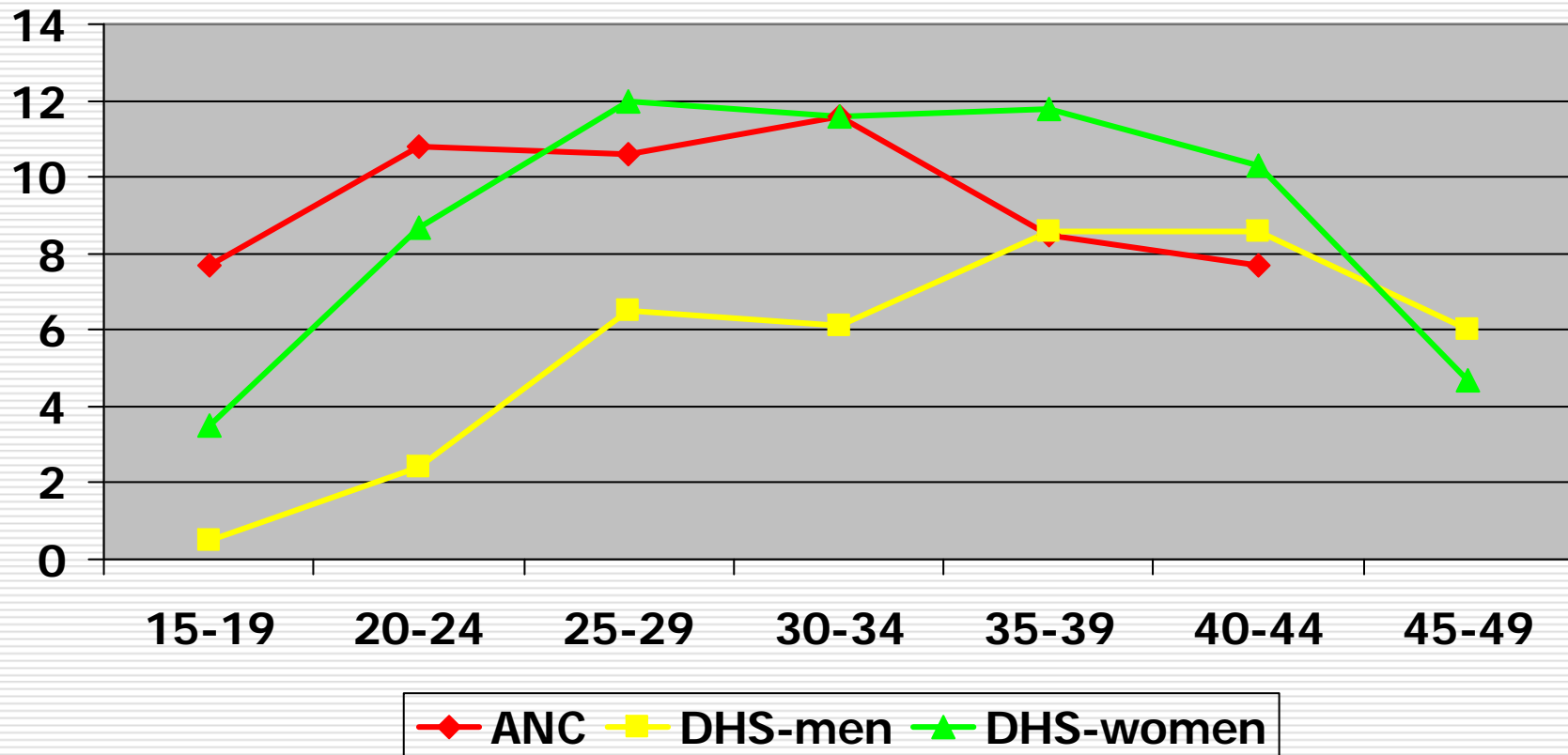
## HIV Prevalence Among Women and Men Cameroon, Kenya, Tanzania, 2003-04

- ❑ Reproductive health choices and infant feeding options

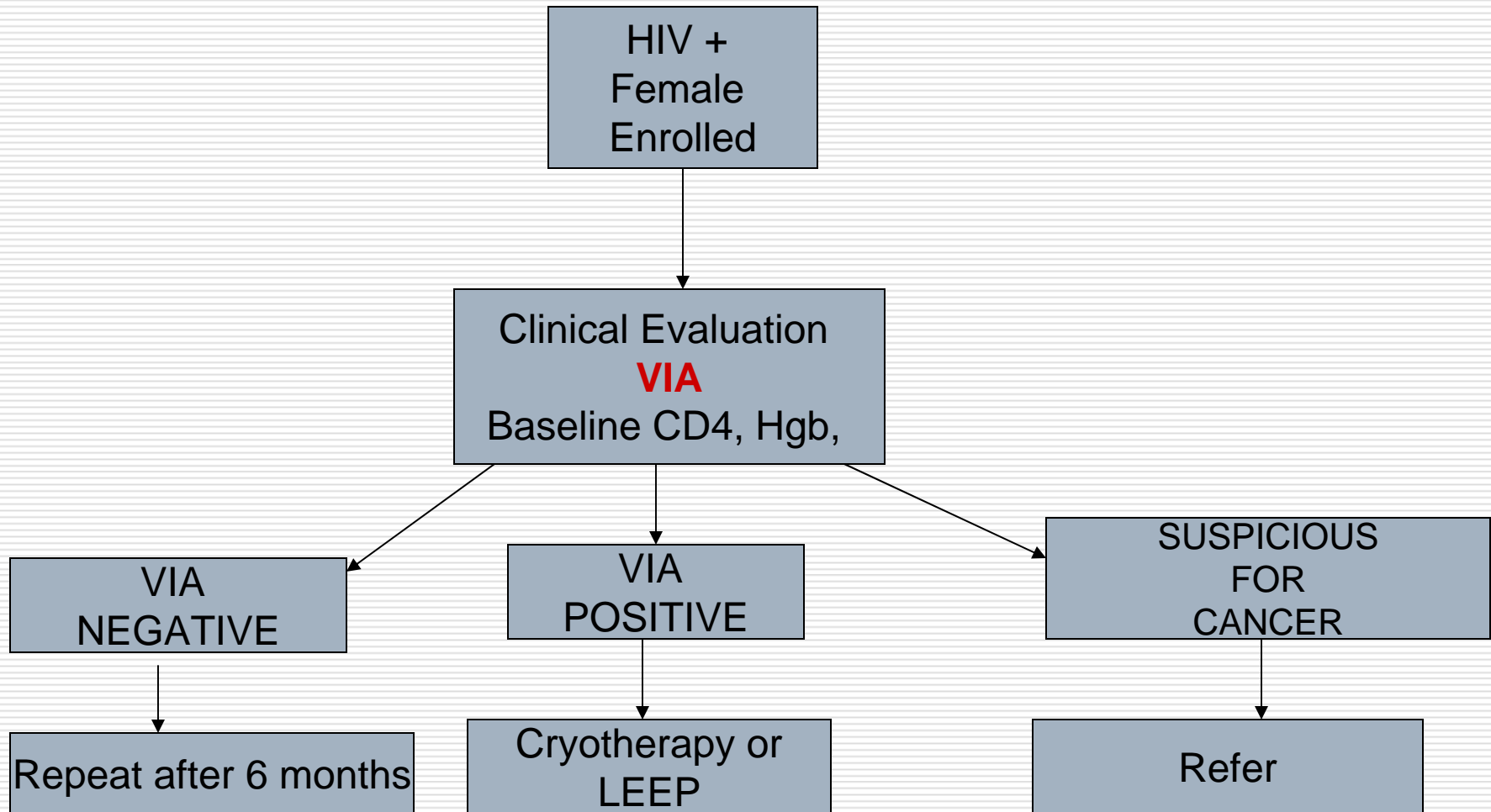
